1.0 PURPOSE

This vehicle specification outlines the minimum build requirements for all vehicles used on <INSERT COMPANY NAME> sites, in conjunction with the sites Traffic Management Plans, to minimise the hazards associated with vehicle usage and interaction.

The intent is to provide a minimum standard guideline for all vehicles on site. Where this guideline is unable to practicably be met refer to section 6.0 for the compliance requirements. It is intended that the distinction be made between mine site based vehicles/equipment and on road registered vehicles/equipment, prior to implementing these specifications. For example, quad road trains utilised for the bulk handling of ore, are on road registered vehicles therefore do not fall under the requirements of this specification unless intra-mine haulage is being conducted. That distinction is to be made by the Accountable Manager prior to the vehicle/equipment coming to site.

2.0 SCOPE

Cargo Barrier	Physical barrier located within the cab, designed to separate personnel from payload.
Emergency Vehicles	Any vehicle responding directly to an emergency which may include but is not limited to, ambulance, fire appliances.
FOPS	Falling Object Protection System
HV	Heavy Vehicle Mobile equipment that can be registered for use on public roads or in excess of 5 tonne Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM) and includes but is not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cranes & forklifts • Skid steer loaders • Explosives, fuel & service trucks • Low loaders (floats) • Road trains and rigid body trucks • Buses carrying more than 12 people
LV	Light Vehicle, Mobile equipment that can be registered for use on a public road that
