- An inspection is mandatory for all light or heavy vehicles / plant before entering operational areas within the <Insert Site Name>site. Goods carrying vehicles must be escorted.
- All light and heavy vehicles / plant must have a daily pre start inspection completed by the first driver or operator on that given shift.
- All light and heavy plant including trailers must be maintained to a standard that ensures all Safety Critical items are functional.
- All defects found on a vehicle or plant must be fixed immediately or have the machine tagged out of service by the operator who discovered the fault or problem.
- Service records must be maintained and documented as per the manufactures recommendations.
- All lights including indicators must be visible.
- Windows of all vehicles must be free from significant cracks or damage. All windows must be cleaned regularly so that vision is not impaired in any way.
- The cabin of all light and heavy vehicles must be clean and free from clutter.
- All items carried on the rear of light vehicles and service trucks must be restrained.
- All maintenance and electrical repairs for servicing or commissioning must be recorded.

4.2. GENERAL TRAFFIC RULES

- All traffic rules, signs and speed limits must be obeyed at all times.
- Seat belts must be worn at all times in moving vehicles. NO SEATBELT NO RIDE!
- Never turn onto a haul road unless you hold a current Pit Permit.
- All incidents involving unplanned movement of, or failure to stop, a vehicle must be reported immediately.

4.3. OPERATOR AUTHORISATION

- All persons operating vehicles shall hold a current licence or certificate. Note the following specific requirements.
- Original and current licences and certificates must be presented at Induction.
- Personnel will only be authorised to operate vehicles or machines if they have completed a recorded familiarisation of that particular machine and have demonstrated competency.

4.4. VISIBILITY

- Lights must be on at all times on all vehicles and plant while travelling within the mine operation before dusk and remain on until sun rise is over.
- If visibility drops below 50 meters (due to fog, dust) the <Insert Position> may halt vehicles within the Pit and Haul road net-work for safety.
